Costume History Research Project (120 points)

You will become an expert on a specific period of costume history. You will research the clothing, accessories, hair and cosmetic styles of the period. We will be spending class time with computers; you will complete the following components of the project:

- Digital Presentation (80 points)—each student will create a digital presentation (Google Slides or PowerPoint) that demonstrates his or her expertise on the assigned historical period. The presentation will be well organized and have consistency of design. Superior presentations will include:
 - At least five images each of female and male figures dressed in the period clothing, arranged chronologically. Please include specific dates when available.
 - At least two images representing common undergarments of the period.
 - At least four images each of female and male hair styles and/or wigs.
 - At least two images of footwear and two images of other accessories of the period.
 - Information about cosmetic practices during the period (the amount of this will vary with the period)
 - At least two interesting facts about daily life during the period.
 - Glossary of Terms at least 8 words and definitions related to the period. Images to support the definitions are strongly encouraged! These might include, but are not limited to, specific names of garments, shoes, jewelry or hairstyles of the assigned period. These terms can be integrated into the presentation or can be on a separate glossary slide(s).
- O **Teaching Notes** (**10 points**)—you will prepare and turn in teaching notes (basically, a script for your presentation) for your slides. This will help you organize what is important about the images you collect and help you conduct a successful presentation. You may wish to utilize the "Notes" feature in PowerPoint, and then print off the whole document.
- Five quiz questions (10 points)—you will type and share five quiz questions based on the information in the presentation. The questions should address major ideas from the historical period. (Maybe some of the glossary terms...) These questions should NOT be in your presentation!!
- Poster (20 points)—you will create a poster with silhouettes of male and female figures
 representative of the period. The poster will be labeled with the name of the period and
 specific date range.
- O After all the presentations, you will take an open note quiz over your class mates' teachings. I may or may not include all of the submitted quiz questions.
