

## THEATRICAL MAKEUP

<u>Course Description</u>: In this one semester course, theatrical makeup students will learn beginning through advanced techniques of stage makeup design and application, including, but not limited to, old-age character, facial hair, 3-D effects and fantasy makeup. Students will apply makeup to themselves and classmates. Students will have the option to act as makeup crew for the FHS Drama productions during the semester of enrollment. This course is recommended for students interested in acting and/or students interested in aspects of technical theatre.

Student Makeup Kit: Each student enrolled in Theatrical Makeup must purchase a student makeup kit. The kit contains more than enough stage quality makeup to complete the course requirements. Kits are available by skin tone; Mrs. Sone can help determine which to select. Kits will be ordered by Mrs. Sone and payments are required prior to receiving your kit. The current price is \$60. If you cannot afford to pay the entire kit fee at this time, you may enter into an installment payment agreement, understanding that payment in full must be received before semester finals. Unpaid kits will be handled like a lost or damaged textbook. Please make checks to "FHS Drama."

Other Supplies: In addition to the student makeup kit, each student will need a few other items to successfully participate in this course: makeup remover (use what you are comfortable with; unscented baby wipes are appropriate and inexpensive), wash cloth and/or hand towel, headband or bobby pins to hold hair off face, a personal tube of mascara, facial moisturizer (if student requires) and digital camera or phone camera (to keep records of all your work). A large, button-front shirt to be used as a smock is recommended. Each student needs to

bring a ½ - 1" three-ring binder or pocket folder to keep in the classroom; we will use this notebook for handouts and graded work.

**Grading**: Students will be graded according to their efforts in assessment of design and application of theatrical makeup. All assignments are graded on a rubric based on concepts discussed before the makeup application. Since Theatrical Makeup is a hands-on course, there will not be a written cumulative final exam; however, there will be a final application during our scheduled final exam period.

<u>Make-up and Late Work</u>: SHOWING UP TO SCHOOL IS INCREDIBLY IMPORTANT IN THEATRE COURSES! Theatrical Makeup is a hands-on class. We will have very little take home work. Missed makeup applications will be made up by appointment only.

<u>Classroom Policies:</u> Mrs. Sone's class will adhere to guidelines and policies as published in the FHS student handbook. <u>BYOD</u>: students with electronic devices, including cell phones, will be expected to use their device in class when Mrs. Sone gives approval or direction.

Major Projects: In addition to the makeup designs and applications, each Theatrical Makeup student will engage in two larger projects. One is the makeup morgue project. In this project, students will collect images that will be useful research for makeup design in a variety of categories. The project will also have a portfolio section, in which the student will display their own work and reflect on the finished products (hence the need for camera or phone camera). The other is reading a play script and designing the makeup for one character; students will present their design to the class.
