

THEATRE I FALL FINAL EXAM

I. With a partner, write and perform a 2-3 minute scene between a psychiatrist and a character from one of the plays we have read this semester (*Antigone*, *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*, *A Play Called Noah's Flood*, and *Everyman*) that address the questions on the character interview handout. A hard copy of the script must be turned in on the day of the final exam. (Or a Shakespeare character).

II. Write a 1-1½ minute monologue in which a psychiatrist seeks advice from another psychiatrist about how to deal with a client. You may not divulge the name of the client but it should be obvious to the class. The client must be a character from one of the plays we have read this semester. (Not Shakespeare) A hard copy of the monologue must be turned in on the day of the final exam.

III. With a partner, write a 2-3 minute scene between two psychiatrists in which one seeks advice from the other about how to deal with a client. The client must be a character from one of the plays we have read this semester. A hard copy of the script must be turned in on the day of the final exam. (Each psychiatrist can have a different a client character).

IV. Perform a monologue from *Antigone* or *Everyman*. (At least 2 minutes) You must also prepare a character interview and turn it in on the day of the final exam.

V. With a partner, perform a 3-4 minute scene from one of the plays we have read this semester. You must each also prepare a character interview and turn it in on the day of the final exam.

VI. With a partner, select a 2-3 minute Shakespeare scene to perform. Turn in the scene translated in your own words along with character interview.

IV. Select a 1-2 minute Shakespeare monologue to perform. Turn in the monologue translated in your own words along with character interview.
